#### From Father's Desk -

In this weekend's bulletin you will find our annual financial reports. These cover the prior fiscal year from July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025. As you can see, all three parishes had a surplus and were in the black. This is thanks to our parish donors who support the work of the Church here in our cluster. Thank you all for your sacrificial support. Every little bit helps. It also assists with caring for our churches going into the future for the generations to come. I want to thank, as well, all of our finance council members at each parish who diligently look over the statements and activities of the parishes four times a year. Each finance council has approved a budget for this year and all are projecting to be in the black again. Your contributions make this happen.

Our cemeteries are also in pretty good shape financially. This year we have a special occurrence, however, which kind of brings our cemeteries to mind. In two weeks, November 2<sup>nd</sup> falls on Sunday. So this year, we will celebrate All Souls Day on Sunday. Our Sunday Masses will be dedicated to All Souls Masses. I will wear the traditional black color for the vestments that day, for "Requiem Masses" (requiem means "peace"). As well, I think it's a good thing to continue to support our cemeteries financially and, having discussed it with the cemetery committees, we decided to take up a second collection on All Souls Day for our cemeteries. Your supporting the sacred resting places for our loved ones will be helpful and much appreciated.

The day before All Souls Day is All Saints Day, of course. It is generally a Holy Day of Obligation, but since it falls on Saturday this year, the USCCB has a policy in place that the obligation is lifted and the day is not a day of obligation. This year, therefore, November 1 is <u>not</u> a Holy Day of Obligation. I will offer one Mass on Saturday morning, on November 1, which will be an All Saints Day Mass for any who wish to attend. The evening Mass on November 1 at St. Patrick will be an All Souls Day Mass in anticipation of the Sunday celebration, as we are instructed to do by the powers that be.

Lastly, as this is World Mission Sunday, the mission of the Church continues in times of strife and persecution. It is preferable to have peace, for the dignity of all and for the promotion of human flourishing and the Gospel. We can be mindful this weekend for the peace process in the Middle East that has begun. We thank God for His inspiration through many different people to make this happen. And we pray that it endures. We pray that innocent life is no longer subjected to terror and violence, and that the higher aspirations which accord with our dignity in Christ may abound.

#### Sacraments

<u>Baptismr.</u> Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
