The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed Readings: II Macc 12:43-46; I Cor 15:51-57; John 5:25-29

#### From Father's Desk -

Today the Church celebrates All Souls Day. The whole month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls. We pray for them in the most important way with Masses for the dead. We offer these "Requiem" Masses (Requiem means "rest") for the repose of their souls. Priests are usually restricted to one Mass per day. For All Souls Day, however, the Church allows, and in that way encourages, a priest to celebrate three Masses so that frequent and fervent prayers are offered for the faithful departed. As part of this, we have the Book of the Dead out in the entryway of each parish, and I encourage you to inscribe the names of your deceased loved ones. We will pray for them throughout the month of November.

Remember that from November 1 through 8 we are encouraged to visit a cemetery and offer prayers for the souls in purgatory, especially our own loved ones. A plenary indulgence for the faithful departed is available to those who make a visit to a cemetery, pray for the faithful departed, and fulfill the usual conditions.

We also have taken up this weekend a second collection for our four cemeteries: St. Ignatius Cemetery just south and east of Spring Valley, St. Patrick Cemetery just on the west edge of LeRoy, St. Finbarr cemetery a half mile west and one mile north of town, and St. Kilian Cemetery a half mile east of the south edge of Wykoff. Thank you for your support of the upkeep and long-term care of our cemeteries.

OCIA has begun. Please think of those you know in your life and if they are at all questioning their own faith, or whether they might want to join the Catholic Church, or if you know someone who for whatever reason never received the Sacrament of Confirmation, encourage them to come. Of course, anyone is invited to come and learn more about the Catholic faith, and I try not to make it too boring!

This week we have the memorial of St. Charles Borromeo. He lived through the middle of the 1500s, was a cardinal and Archbishop of Milan who played a key role in implementing the reforms of the Council of Trent. One of his most important contributions was that he worked to systematize priestly formation, founding seminaries to train priests.

Next Sunday a feast day trumps the Sunday of Ordinary Time, so we will be celebrating the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. It is the pope's cathedral church, even though St. Peter's is used far more often because of its historical importance. As the huge engraving reads on the front of the church, St. John Lateran is *omnium urbis et orbis ecclesiarum mater et caput*, "the mother and head of all the churches of the city and of the world."





#### Sacraments

<u>Baptismr.</u> Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
