From Father's Desk -

This week, I am away with the priests of the Diocese of Winona-Rochester and with Bishop Barron for our annual convocation. I am back for daily Mass on Friday. This Saturday is a 1st Saturday, so we will also have Mass then. I regret there won't be daily Mass or Adoration on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday. But the bishops of our diocese over the last many years have judged it important to have this annual gathering.

Thank you to everyone who worked the St. Ignatius Fall Dinner & Raffle. It was a great day. I was told we ran out of chicken, and I'm not sure if that is a good thing or a bad thing. In the end, it was a good time together and I'm grateful to all who made it happen.

I write this before Wednesday evening Faith Formation, but I am gearing up to teach the Confirmation class again to our cluster's 10th graders. We always fall way behind what I hope to accomplish during these days, as I can get caught up in one topic or another and it takes much longer than it should. I hope this time with this last grade in faith formation helps these young minds begin to grapple with the reality of living in accord with the will and example of Jesus Christ. I try to give a basic grasp of the faith, and how reasonable, serene and freeing it is. We always discuss the seven sacraments and the Ten Commandments, as well. These topics are often not well understood at the younger ages, and sometimes are a little too lofty or complex for even 10th graders. We give it a go, nonetheless. Hopefully things will echo and resonate in the back of their minds some years in the future when they're needed. "Oh yeah... I think Father said something about that once."

I hope it also demonstrates the absolute beauty and wisdom of our faith. Everything works together in a complete whole. And it is utterly reasonable, when correctly presented and understood. And it embraces all of the best and highest of human endeavor and achievement: philosophical reflection, musical brilliance, physical beauty, interpersonal relations, scientific rigor, moral uprightness. It all comes together, and can be seen in the life of Jesus Christ, and His reflections in the saints who pursued all of these aspects of human life, and more. There is nothing to fear about the faith embracing it all—it only makes it richer, more coherent, and more fascinating. Bishop Barron talks often that God wants to captivate us and entice us by beauty and grandeur of it all.



Sacraments

<u>Baptismr.</u> Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
