## January 5, 2025 The Epiphany of the Lord Readings: Isaiah 60:1-6; Ephesians 3:2-3a, 5-6; Matthew 2: 1-12

### From Father's Desk -

Because of the New Year holiday and the Mary, Mother of God Holy Day, I am able to write this article after the Mass with Bishop Barron at St. Patrick in LeRoy. I am most appreciative to everyone who was there, and those who helped make the day special. Thank you, ladies, for putting on the lunch! The soups, sandwiches and bars were delicious. Thanks to Pat and all who were in the choir. Thanks to our reader, ushers, greeters, decorators, counters, and our Lewis & Drees family servers. It was a glorious day, even if a bit chilly! Bishop Barron celebrated Mass and preached a beautiful homily. He highlighted those three words from the Gospel for the day: do God's will always with **haste**, eagerness and without delay; let the profound beauty of our faith and the Incarnation of Christ **amaze** and astound us still today; and **keep** and treasure all God's words, actions and blessings in our lives.

Bishop Barron also relayed that he intends for our local church to have a diocesan synod this next year. A couple of the things he wants us to focus on are evangelization and vocations. This has been his continual emphasis since he arrived in the diocese two and a half years ago. The statistics indicate that only about 20% of Catholics regularly attend Mass. As he said: this is terrible. He renewed his call for each of us to strive to bring just one person to Mass this next year. If we can each get one person to come back to attending Mass, it will have a profound impact on our parishes, on our church, and on the world. Please do what you can to prayerfully and graciously invite someone to come to Mass. Invite them to meet you at the door and sit with you. Do whatever you can to lower the bar, as it were, to make it as encouraging and easy as possible to cross the threshold of our church doors.

This year we have, as I mentioned briefly previously, about the longest Christmas season that our liturgical calendar permits. Sometimes with how Christmas falls during the week, we end up celebrating the feast of Epiphany and the Baptism of the Lord back to back, on a Sunday and Monday. This year, they are spaced out a week apart, so we get a rightly protracted Christmas season. I hope you will take this time to continue to gaze upon our Nativity scenes in each of our churches. Meditate on the absolute littleness of the whole thing. It means everything for the history of the world, but in that moment, actually living through that moment, there's a way in which it all goes unnoticed. The whole world around Joseph and Mary don't even know there's something happening which they are missing. The righteous are attentive to what's happening and are filled with contemplation and wonder, but for everyone else, there is absolutely nothing to even take note of.

#### Sacraments

<u>Baptism</u>. Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
