April 13, 2025 Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord Readings: Isaiah 50:4-7; Philippians 2:6-11; Luke 22:14-23:56

From Father's Desk -

Holy Week has arrived. This is the busiest week of the year liturgically. Not only do have the liturgies of the Sacred Triduum, but also the bishop celebrates the Chrism Mass, and we often schedule extra times for Confession so that everyone can celebrate a proper Easter. What an abundance of God's grace!

On Monday, I will travel to Heron Lake–waaaaay out west–to join Bishop Barron in the celebration of the Chrism Mass. This is a Mass that historically and by design is meant for Holy Thursday morning. The bishop gathers with his priests, his presbyterate, to celebrate this special Mass on the same day that Jesus instituted the priesthood. (The size of our diocese justifies moving it to Monday of Holy Week.) The Chrism Mass is an annual renewal for priests. The bishop publicly asks us to renew certain promises: to devotedly serve God and His people by being faithful to prayer, the celebration of the sacraments and teaching well. The bishop then asks the lay faithful who are present to pray for all the priests and himself, so that we might be faithful ministers.

The Chrism Mass also serves as a special opportunity for the bishop to, implicitly, commission his priests to serve the faithful of his diocese. The bishop blesses the Oil of Catechumens and the Oil of the Sick which are kept for the whole year and used by his priests in the Sacraments of Baptism and the Anointing of the Sick, respectively. The bishop then consecrates the Sacred Chrism which is used in the Sacrament of Confirmation and when celebrating the ordination of priests and bishops. Chrism is also used in the baptism of infants, but as a precursor and foreshadowing of confirmation. Since priests are to guard these oils and use them all year long, the oils serve as reminders each time the priest uses them that the bishop has given him these oils and entrusts his ministry as a successor of the apostles to the priest.

Three other things to note. First, please help with prayer after the Holy Thursday Mass with adoration into the night. This is a beautiful way to stay awake and keep vigil with Jesus, when he would be offering his anguished prayer in the garden.

Second, the Sunday after Easter Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday and we will have a celebration of the devotion at 3:00 pm with the praying of the chaplet, some time for confession, and benediction. Please come, and invite your friends!

Lastly, there are some extra times for Confession this week, if you haven't made your Lenten confession, yet:

Sacraments

<u>Baptism</u>. Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
