April 20, 2025 The Resurrection of the Lord – Easter Sunday Readings: Acts 10:34a-37-43; Colossians 3:1-4; John 20:1-9

From Father's Desk -

Christ is risen! He is risen, indeed! This Paschal acclamation is one way to remember, all 50 days of the Easter season, the reason for our joy. Jesus has conquered sin and death. In instituting the college of the apostles, giving them authority over the life of the church, and the power to perform the sacraments, Jesus Christ has given us access to the Father. Especially through the sacramental life of the Church, we can access that sanctifying grace which preserves the life of grace, the very life of the Blessed Trinity within us. For those who turn away from sin and towards His mercy in the sacraments, the glorified life we see on this day of Jesus' wondrous resurrection from the dead to the glorified life can be ours, too.

Pope Saint John Paul II instituted Divine Mercy Sunday for the universal church. The Sunday after Easter, as Jesus appears to His apostles to confirm them in this new life of the Resurrection, we celebrate the abundant grace of God's mercy and compassion. We will have a celebration next Sunday in the afternoon for the Divine Mercy devotion. We will gather at 3:00 pm, the hour of mercy, the time of our Savior's death on the cross, and pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, concluding the hour with Benediction. I hope you will come and experience the abundance of grace which God pours upon us His children.

The church has another devotion which we pray throughout the Easter season to capture this Paschal joy. In place of praying the *Angelus* three times a day at 6:00 am, 12:00 noon, and 6:00 pm, we replace that prayer with the *Regina Caeli* which is focused on the Resurrection. I encourage you to pray it as much as you can this Easter:

V.\ Queen of heaven, rejoice, alleluia.

R.\ For He whom you did merit to bear, alleluia.

V.\ Has risen as he said, alleluia.

R.\ Pray for us to God, alleluia.

V.\ Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.

R.\ For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia.

Let us pray. O God, who gave joy to the world through the resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may obtain the joys of everlasting life. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

Sacraments

<u>Baptism</u>. Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
