April 27, 2025 Second Sunday of Easter – Sunday of Divine Mercy Readings: Acts 5:12-16; Revelation 1:9-11a, 12-13, 17-19; John 20:19-31

From Father's Desk -

"Non habemus papam." This was the message that my priest friend who is serving as a Navy chaplain in Japan sent me when he woke me up very early on Monday morning to tell me the pope had died. It's a play on the announcement of a new pope: "Habemus papam!" We have a pope! There are plenty of very good articles and stories you can read about the life and ministry of Pope Francis. I encourage you to take some time and read some of them. Yesterday, Saturday, was his funeral Mass, which begins the Novendiales, nine days of mourning the death of the pope and offering Masses for his soul. Even though it is the Easter season, many of the liturgical commemoration for our Masses this week will be Requiem Masses praying for the repose of Pope Francis' soul.

We each should pray for Pope Francis and remember him. Two things that stuck out to me about his work. He is probably the pope of the last 50 years who has talked the most about the devil! Whether colloquially in an interview or in his Sunday Angelus messages, Pope Francis seems to have mentioned the danger that Satan poses more than Pope Benedict or Pope John Paul II. Pope Francis appeared to be keenly aware of the prowler and his efforts. As well, I especially appreciate his steadfast preaching on the dignity of life. He never wavered about protecting the life of every child in the womb. He condemned our modern world's "throwaway culture", which has led to the discarding of things that are uncomfortable for us, including even human life. May he rest in peace.

Today, we will have the celebration of Divine Mercy at 3:00 pm at St. Ignatius. This is a beautiful devotion which is at the heart of the Easter mystery: God died in the flesh so as to liberate us from slavery to sin and grant us forgiveness. The church has always contemplated God's mercy during the Easter season, especially this second Sunday of Easter as the Gospel is about the power to forgive that Jesus bestows upon the Apostles. It has taken on a more profound celebration since the year 2,000 when Pope St. John Paul II inaugurated the feast of Divine Mercy Sunday, inspired by the life of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska and her Diary which records the visions she received from the Lord.

Next weekend, we celebrate First Communion with our youngsters who have spent this year preparing for the sacrament. It coincides with the first Sunday in May, so we will very appropriately begin the weekend Masses with May Crowning of our Blessed Mother. There's a beauty in the coincidence of these events: as the mother of new life, Mary accompanies us along the way as we grow in the life of the Church. Mary stands vigil here, too, as these children are advancing in their participation in the life of the sacraments by beginning to receive the Eucharist. Please pray for our First Communicants and their families next weekend.

Sacraments

<u>Baptism</u>. Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
