# May 4, 2025 Third Sunday of Easter Readings: Acts 5:27-32, 40b-41; Revelation 5:11-14; John 21:1-19

### From Father's Desk -

Godspeed and the richest of blessings to our young people who have received their First Holy Communion this weekend. It's a very special grace, and we pray for them to grasp the wonder of God's love for them. Sometimes you will hear some people talk fondly of remembering their First Holy Communion and what it was like, what they wore, who was there, and many other details. I confess, I don't remember a thing about mine. I have seen pictures of me dressed up after the Mass was over, but I still don't have any concrete memories of it. I suppose everyone is different, and I hope many of our young people will remember and cherish this day for years to come.

You might notice some things are simpler with the Masses this year. An important aim in celebrating with our young people is to make sure we don't overload them with too many things to do. There is one thing for them to do this day: receive Jesus in the Holy Eucharist with as much love and devotion as they can muster. Everything else can quickly become a distraction, taking us away from that central gift. St. Thérèse of Lisieux wrote beautifully that she remembered every detail of her First Holy Communion and that whole day. She reflects on the moment she received Jesus:

"I would not tell you everything, even if I could, for there are certain things which lose their fragrance in the open air, certain thoughts so intimate that they cannot be translated into earthly language without losing at once their deep and heavenly meaning. How lovely it was, that first kiss of Jesus in my heart — it was truly a kiss of love. I knew that I was loved and said, 'I love You, and I give myself to You forever.'"

St. Thérèse begins talking about her younger self in the third person:

"And her joy became so vast, so deep, that now it overflowed. Soon she was weeping, to the astonishment of her companions, who said to one another later on: 'Why did she cry? Was there something on her conscience? Perhaps it was because her mother was not there, or the Carmelite sister she loves so much.' It was beyond them that all the joy of Heaven had entered one small, exiled heart, and that it was too frail and weak to bear it without tears. As if the absence of my mother could make me unhappy on the day of my First Communion! As all Heaven entered my soul when I received Jesus, my mother came to me as well. Nor could I cry because you were not there, we were closer than ever before. It was joy alone, deep ineffable joy that filled my heart."

I pray we all can understand what an immense gift it is, and may we never take it for granted, to receive Our Lord and God in Holy Communion, Jesus Christ who gave His whole self for us-Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity.

#### Sacraments

<u>Baptism</u>. Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
