From Father's Desk -

Christ is risen! He is risen, indeed!

Last weekend's First Communion Masses went very well and were truly meaningful. Many thanks to all of our catechists and faith formation coordinators for the work you put in to prepare these young people for the special day. We owe gratitude to the parents of these second graders for faithfully bringing your children to class, being an example for them, and helping them to prepare for the day, as well. One of the most important blessings you can give them as they now grow closer to Jesus in receiving Holy Communion is to continue to bring them to Mass to experience this closeness regularly.

Our Faith Formation years are all wrapping up, and I want to thank all of our families that bring their children and who support the programs. They cannot happen without the help of everyone. As well, we owe a great debt of gratitude to all of you who volunteer in our programs—catechists, helpers, volunteers for projects and other activities. God bless and reward you for your fidelity.

The year is not quite over for our tenth graders, however. This last Wednesday, our Confirmation students participated in the retreat put on by the NET team, ahead of receiving the sacrament. There is one class left this week, and then practice next week, a week before Confirmation. Bishop Barron will go to St. Bernard in Stewartville on Wednesday, May 28, to give the Sacrament of Confirmation to youth from our area. Please pray for these young people during these last weeks while they make their final preparations to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

The diocese has slightly changed how Confirmations are scheduled and celebrated. There are now about 20 celebrations across the diocese for all the parishes. Each parish or cluster signs up for the one they find most convenient, which might mean there are three or four clusters who are attending one Confirmation Mass. For the one we will be attending, there will be young people from our cluster, the Stewartville/Simpson cluster, as well as the Byron/Kasson/Dodge Center cluster. Because of these larger groups, there is limited space for family members to attend.

We're already looking forward to next year's Faith Formation. Our catechism programs can always use more volunteers and helpers. Please consider helping out as a catechist to teach our young people. You can also help just by sitting in class, or with special projects through the year. Prayerfully consider how you might help with this next year's program.

Sacraments

<u>Baptism</u>. Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
