The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity
Readings: Proverbs 8:22-31; 1 Romans 5:1-5; John 16:12-15

From Father's Desk -

The Diocese is finalizing plans for the Synod on Evangelization and Vocations which will be held in August. Please pray for the success of the synod, the judgement of all of the participants, and the discernment of Bishop Barron who will consider all of the discussions. Typically, at the end of a synod, the bishop would put together a document for the diocese to implement. Sometimes it's more general, and more of an encouragement to live the faith in a particular way. Sometimes it is programmatic and it has specific steps to enact or policies to change and abide by. With one on evangelization and vocations, it could be anything or all three of those: encouragement to live the faith authentically, to do catechesis well, to perform greater outreach for participating in the life of the parish, and to promote vocations. It could also have some specific policies to enact regarding parish vocation-oriented programs, specific plans to reach out to disaffected people, or a particular program to implement for faith formation. Those are just some of the various possibilities. What will actually come of the synod is not determined, yet, and depends upon our prayer, our participation, the bishop's discernment and mostly the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

Today is Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity—the central belief of our faith, that God is a communion of Divine Persons and He has invited us to participate in His very life. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches about the Trinity:

232. Christians are baptized "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Before receiving the sacrament, they respond to a three-part question when asked to confess the Father, the Son and the Spirit: "I do." "The faith of all Christians rests on the Trinity."

233. Christians are baptized in the *name* of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit: not in their *names*, for there is only one God, the almighty Father, his only Son and the Holy Spirit: the Most Holy Trinity.

234. The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith". The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin".

Sacraments

<u>Baptismr.</u> Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
