From Father's Desk -

Once again, I want to thank Fr. Tim Reker for substituting this weekend as I finish up my vacation with my family. This is a trip my family has taken since before I was born. And vacation is restorative. Really it's just another form of a Sabbath—taking time for rest, to be with family, be refreshed for the work ahead. Pope Leo has restored the practice of getting out of the city of Rome for some weeks during the summer. It has been a long tradition for the popes to head to Castel Gandolfo, only about 20 miles away, where the temperature is somewhat nicer up on the higher ground. Importantly, I would presume, it not only gives the pope some time away from the Vatican offices, but it allows all the workers who take care of the papal offices and residence time that they can all get away—caretakers, cleaners, cooks, and all the rest.

Of course, the pope is always the pope. So, even at Castel Gandolfo he says Mass, he prays the Sunday Angelus with tourists and pilgrims, he even sometimes meets leaders and dignitaries while there. So, too, when priests go on vacation, we still pray the breviary for the Church and for our people, and we still offer the Mass. The Code of Canon Law, in canon 904, strongly encourages priests to celebrate Mass daily, and says it's the primary responsibility of priests: "Remembering always that in the mystery of the eucharistic sacrifice the work of redemption is exercised continually, priests are to celebrate frequently; indeed, daily celebration is recommended earnestly since, even if the faithful cannot be present, it is the act of Christ and the Church in which priests fulfill their principal function."

(I'm writing this before I leave:) I will celebrate Mass daily and will remember all of you in my prayers. You might notice that the Sunday *Pro Populo* ("for the people") Mass intention was not listed these last two weekends in the bulletin when there was a substitute. As your pastor, I take that responsibility seriously and fulfill it myself. I could hand it off to another, which the Church's law allows, but why would I? It is one of my most important responsibilities: to pray for all of you, and to offer that greatest prayer for you, the Mass. Please pray for me in return—not only today or this week, but every day!

In two weeks, we will have a religious sister from the Rochester Franciscans with us for our annual missionary cooperative appeal. We were supposed to have one of them with us last year, also, but something intervened and prevented sister from making it to our Masses. This appeal, of course, supports several different missions of the Church and helps to remind us of all the parts of the Church here at home and far abroad. Your mindfulness and generosity to the sisters and the missionary cooperative will be appreciated, as all your gifts are.



Sacraments

<u>Baptismr.</u> Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
