August 3, 2025 Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: Ecclesiastes 1:2, 2:21-23; Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11; Luke 12:13-21

From Father's Desk -

There are several great saint days which the Church celebrates these weeks during the summer.

On July 22, we honor St. Mary Magdalene. Mary followed Jesus zealously after her conversion, and supported his ministry. She was there at the feet of Jesus when He visited her home in Bethany. She was there shortly before His passion, anointing His feet. She was there at the foot of the Cross, standing alongside the Mother of God. And she was there at the tomb in the morning on Resurrection day, looking for Jesus. St. Mary Magdalene's whole life was given over to God after her encounter with Our Savior.

On July 29, the Church celebrated the feast day of Sts. Martha, Mary and Lazarus. These are the three siblings who became dedicated to Jesus' saving mission—which includes Mary Magdalene. The Church placed this feast as a sort of octave day, the eighth day after Mary Magdalene, to celebrate them once again. Because Lazarus had been raised from the dead, which gave a proof to Jesus' true nature, some sought to kill him. Sts. Martha, Mary and Lazarus left the Holy Land, travelled to France, and were witnesses to Jesus' saving Gospel there.

On July 25, the Church celebrated the first of the Apostles to be martyred for the faith, St. James. Called James the Great or James the Greater, he followed Jesus before James the Less, and was one of the first to follow Jesus as He was beginning His public ministry. James (along with his brother John and also Peter) was graced by Jesus to experience some of the great mysteries of our faith: the raising of the daughter of Jairus, the transfiguration on Mount Tabor, and the agony of Our Lord in the garden of Gethsemane.

Not to be confused with the patron saint of the Spring Valley parish, on July 31 the Church honors the founder of the Jesuits who lived in the 1500s, St. Ignatius of Loyola. (St. Ignatius of Antioch is the patron of Spring Valley.) St. Ignatius wrote an insightful guide for discernment which has assisted the Jesuits and many others for these 500 years. As well, he put together a plan for a 30-day retreat which is still used in Jesuit formation today, as well as by many others who are looking for spiritual renewal in their life.

And just this past Friday, the Church celebrated St. Alphonsus Liguori. During a period of theological debate about moral theology, St. Alphonsus was able to help find the true way of moral decision making which avoided absurd strictness and also pathetic laziness. You might recognize his name from one of the most well-known versions of the Stations of the Cross, as he wrote a beautiful version which has been utilized by many for their Lenten devotions.

Sacraments

<u>Baptismr.</u> Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Parrott.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>. This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Fr. Parrott or Fr. Collins (LeRoy, 507-289-7637).
